Gathering your students' responses to these questions will begin the process of getting to know your students, their expectations about their study and the paper, and help you to find out a little about their background and experience. The students will be prompted to think about why they have enrolled for the paper and to clarify their expectations. Building students' self-knowledge is a good step in helping them to prepare for their learning, and knowing this information will inform your teaching.
